Intermediate classes are held at 8:45 pm and again on Thursday evenings. Some classes offer more advanced dance instruction, while others include challenging dances, such as the tango.

It took me 20 years of marriage to finally persuade my husband to take dance lessons with me. He was hesitant at first, but by the third week, he couldn't wait to go to class, even when I wasn't able to join him. My daughter had such a great time at our graduation dance that she and her friends signed up for the next session.

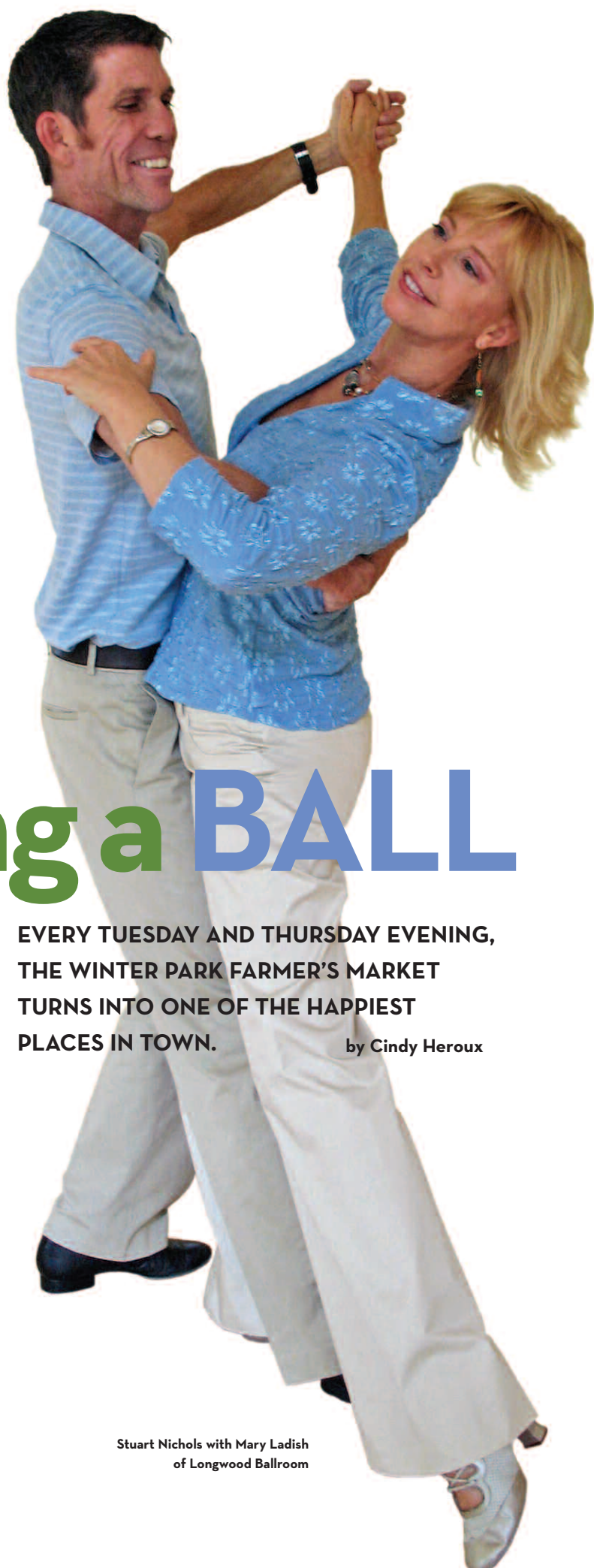
